



Backstage Alcohol Policy

THE LENSIC THEATRE MAINTAINS A LIQUOR LICENSE FOR OUR LOBBY BAR. THE LIQUOR LICENSE PLACES US UNDER THE SAME RULES AND RESTRICTIONS AS ANY OTHER LICENSED BAR IN NEW MEXICO, THIS INCLUDES ALL THE BACKSTAGE AREAS.

ALL REGULATIONS SET FORTH BY THE NEW MEXICO LIQUOR CONTROL BOARD MUST BE ADHERED TO AT ALL TIMES. WE RECOGNIZE THE EXPECTATIONS OF PERFORMERS TO HAVE AVAILABLE CERTAIN ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES AT TIMES. THE FOLLOWING PROCEDURES ARE SET FORTH TO FACILITATE LEGALLY FULFILLING THESE NEEDS.

- Requested alcoholic beverages must be purchased thru the Lensic Liquor License with a formal request to the Production Manager.
- To obtain specific alcohol for consumption backstage you must make a request with the Production Manager at least one week in advance of the requested date. The request must include the type and amount of alcohol and the date and times it should be available for consumption. The charges for alcohol will appear on perishables.
- No Alcoholic beverages may be brought into the Lensic under any circumstances. Any alcoholic beverages brought into the Lensic will be confiscated and disposed of without compensation
- Requested alcoholic beverages will only be available while a licensed New Mexico server is present. All liquor will be returned to the Lensic bar when the servers shift is done. Labor charges for the server will appear on perishables, there will be a 2hr minimum required (\$40).
- Requested alcoholic beverages will be made available in the Green Room; beverages may be taken anywhere onstage or backstage but cannot be taken out of the building, into the auditorium proper, or lobby.
- Beverages purchased from the servers in the lobby cannot leave the lobby and come backstage.
- No Alcohol may ever be consumed by anyone under the age of 21
- No Alcohol will be served to persons who appear intoxicated.
